Jon Cattapan speaks on his artistic journey as an Australian War Memorial Official Artist responding to the subject of peacekeeping in Timor Leste in 2009 in the exhibition *Perspectives: Jon Cattapan & eX de Medici*.

Cattapan's works deal with universal themes concerning how people interact and communicate with each other, all the while playing with our everyday notions of space and time. But the artist also makes his works specific to his deployment, interspersing them with depictions of Australian peacekeepers and Timorese people, topographical and night-time landscapes, and the daily activities of the Australian Defence Force.
